



Message from the Superintendent

I would like to start by expressing my sincere appreciation for your support of the 2017-18 budget. A lot of hard work went into putting this budget together, and no decision was made lightly. Our work will not stop here, though. We will continue our efforts to obtain the Foundation Aid from New York State that our district and students are entitled to.

Year after year, our district faces significant budget shortfalls due to issues with State Aid funding, and it has to stop. The loss of that funding is detrimental to the education our students receive. Members of our District Parent Council have drafted a petition to Governor Cuomo that requests him to take immediate action to fully fund the original Foundation Aid formula for public schools.

We need as many members of our community to sign this petition as possible. The more signatures we can collect and deliver to Governor Cuomo about this extremely important issue, the more likely he is to take action. Every single signature counts.

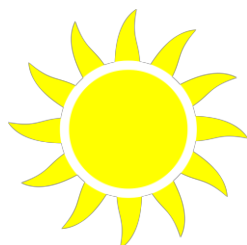
